



## Water Meter

### Which of your household appliances uses the most water?

The table below gives a rough guide to how much water your household appliances might use and how much they could cost each time you use them.

Activity	Typical consumption	Typical cost
<b>Flushing the toilet</b> -Pre 2001 -Post 2001	10litres 5litres	2p 1p
<b>Brushing your teeth</b> (with Tap running)	100 litres 40 litres	22p 9p
<b>Having a bath</b>	80 litres	18p



<b>Using a washing machine</b>	80litres	18p
<b>Using a dishwasher</b>	25litres	6p
<b>Washing up (bowl or sink)</b>	10litres	2p
<b>Cooking/food preparation</b>	17litres	4p
